1. Cataloguing and maintaining the Helen Frankenthaler Foundation art collection for loans to museum exhibitions and in preparation for a future catalogue raisonne. Works of art were lent to the Denver Art Museum, the Mint Museum in Charlotte, N.C., the Royal Academy of Art in London, U.K., the Fonds Helene and Edouard Leclerc in Landerneau, France, and the New Britain Museum of Art in Connecticut. Preparation of works and arrangements for future loans to museum exhibitions at the Montclair Art Museum, New Jersey, the Museum of Contemporary Art in Jacksonville, FL, the Clark Art Institute in Williamstown, MA, the Provincetown Art Association and Museum, Massachusetts, and the Parrish Art Museum, New York were undertaken.
