We partner with foreign charities caring for children in difficult circumstances. In this, we provide these charities with small grants of
several thousand dollars each to help them pay their staff members and other expenses related to collaborating with us. Specifically, every
organization that partners with us needs to take and label photos of many hundreds of children. Our volunteer artists then study those
photos in order to create the artistic portraits that we ultimately deliver as gifts to the children.
We monitor the use of these small grants to these foreign charities simply by observing that they have succeeded in taking and labeling all
the photos of the children for the project.
In 2016, we gave a total of \$20,968 in grants to seven different foreign charities, but we did not give more than \$5,000 to any one individually.
