

These expe	enses decreased substantially in 2015 and leveled off in 2016.
With the co	ompletion of the project, the overall level of contributions to the organization deceased over 50% between 2014 and 2015.
Three cont	ributors provided major support for this capital project in 2012, 2013, and 2014.
With the co	ompletion of this project, the percentage of contributions from these individuals has decreased substantially.
However, t	he five year average for public support remains slightly under 33% at 29%.
However, t	he percentage of public support in 2016 increased to 44%; well above the requirement for a 501c3.
The expect	tation is that the percentage of public support will remain over 33% for the foreseeable future.
Within a fe	w years, it is expected that the five year average will rise above 33 %.
