### C. HOW DOES A QUALIFIED ADVOCATE APPLY?

- 1.A Qualified Advocate must complete the online Here to Help Foundation Application.
- 2.Do not fax an application. Only submit online.
- 3.Do not have the applicant fill out the application. Only the Qualified Advocate can complete and submit the application.

### D. WHAT OCCURS ONCE AN APPLICATION IS SUBMITTED?

- 1.If an application is successfully submitted, the Qualified Advocate will be immediately directed to a web page confirming the application was received.
- If, instead, there are errors in the application, these errors will be shown at the top of the application page. The Advocate will then need to correct all errors and push the "Submit entry" button again.

2.The staff of the Here to Help Foundation will review the application and all the required documentation and reply via email to the Qualified Advocate with any additional questions and/or requests for documentation. This will usually occur within 48 hours of the receipt of the application.

### E. WHAT OCCURS IF A GRANT IS AWARDED?

The Here to Help Foundation does not provide money to the individual directly but to the service provider or creditor (i.e. car repair shop, landlord, utility service etc.).
