THE VAST MAJORITY OF THESE LIAISONS ARE IN THEIR 20'S AND 30'S. RECOGNIZING THE OPPORTUNITY TO PROVIDE A RICH JEWISH AND PROFESSIONAL LEARNING EXPERIENCE FOR THE LIAISONS, THE PROGRAM HAS BEEN EXPANDED TO MAKE THAT A PRIMARY GOAL, WITH THE RESULT THAT THE LIAISONS GAIN AN IMMEASURABLE SENSE OF THEMSELVES AS JEWISH LEADERS AND COMMUNITY PARTICIPANTS.
