The Chair announced that the purpose of the meeting is to consider and authorize (1) the designation and appointment the Oppenheimer Trust Company of Delaware (the "Oppenheimer Trust Company") as a director of the corporation; (2) the resolution and authorization that the Oppenheimer Trust Company will hereafter be retained to provide administrative services to the corporation; (3) the execution, by the Secretary of the corporation, of a First Amendment to the Bylaws of the corporation to provide for three directors to serve on the Board (instead of five, as stated in the original Bylaws); and (4) the appointment and/or election and confirmation of the persons who constitute the officers and directors of the corporation.

Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following preamble and resolutions were adopted:

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the corporation consider that it is reasonable and appropriate that (1) The Oppenheimer Trust Company be designated and appointed as a director of the corporation, and (2) The Oppenheimer Trust Company be retained to provide administrative services to the corporation.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that (1) The Oppenheimer Trust Company is designated and appointed as a director of the corporation; and (2) the Oppenheimer Trust Company is hereby retained to provide administrative services to the corporation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the proper officers of this corporation be and they hereby are authorized and directed to execute the appropriate documents to facilitate such appointment and retention of the Oppenheimer Trust Company,

including (1) the execution of a First Amendment to the Bylaws of the corporation to provide for three directors to serve on the Board (instead of five, as stated in the original Bylaws); and (2) the execution of any retention agreement or retention documents which the Oppenheimer Trust Company may require in connection with such appointment and retention

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the corporation consider that it is reasonable and appropriate that the Board confirm the appointment and/or election of the persons who constitute the officers and directors of the corporation.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the following persons and/or entities constitute the current directors and officers of the corporation:

Directors: (1) Kimberly Reagan-Hackett; (2) Shaunc Hackett; and (3) the Oppenheimer Trust Company

Officers: (1) Kimberly Reagan-Hackett, President and corporate Chair; and (2) Shaune Hackett, Vice President and Corporate Secretary
