	requires a license through the WV DHHR. The regulations for the typles of facility and facility safety measures are extrememly
	important adding additional expense. We currently rent a center with the square footage to provide services for 110 children at a give
	time, but operate the center in many shifts This allows the center to care for more than 200 different children in any given day. The
	facility also has a completely equipped kitchen. This allows our program to participate in the WV Child Nutrition Program. Almost all
	of our funding is from the two WV groverment agencies which help provide services for low income children. The revenue for WV DHHR is related to the building and also to employee payroll expense.
	WV DHIRK IS related to the building and also to employee payron expense

	amount of staff are classroom providers. We also have kitchen, maintenance and administrative positions.
