EVERY WEDNESDAY DURING THE SCHOOL YEAR DURING THEIR PHYSICAL EDUCATION CLASS WE'D TEACH THE FIRST TEE CURRICULUM. AT MOSHOLU WE STARTED THE 1ST EVER PGA JUNIOR LEAGUE TEAM, ALL THE MEMBERS OF OUR LEAGUE WERE FIRST TEE PARTICIPANTS (40). WE MADE IT TO THE 3RD ROUND OF THE PAYOFFS BEFORE WE GOT ELIMINATED. WE ALSO STARTED THE FIRST TEE JUNIOR LEAGUE CERTIFYING CLASS A MOSHOLU, WHERE PARTICIPANTS WOULD HAVE A CHANCE TO PAY ON THE COURSE MORE OFTEN AND COMPETE AGAINST OTHER PARTICIPANTS ALONG WITH WORKING ON THEIR LIFE SKILLS.
