Between 10% and 20% of Atlanta pets are destroyed annually, almost double the national rate. Sadly, Atlanta is not meeting the challenge and achieving advancements as well as other American cities. Although pet overpopulation is not an easy problem to correct, those cities that have provided affordable and accessible spay/neuter programs have seen the sharpest decline in euthanasia rates.

GOAL: Align the supply of animals in Atlanta with demand by offering affordable and accessible spay/neuter programs. in 5 years we intend to decrease the number of homeless pets by 80%, from 100,000 to 20,000.
