They are restricted to those organizations whose exempt function is for charitable, medical, scientific or educational purposes, with emphasis on innovative short-term youth development, public education, aid to the handicapped and disadvantaged, cultural programs, women's issues and programs that have the promise of a solution. No grants are awarded to individuals, government services, public school services required by law, deficit financing, loans, annual campaigns, religious organizations for religious purposes, propaganda or political causes.
