	in Cuyahoga County and approximately half of these families have dual involvement in the child welfare system. The Pay
	for Success project aims to reunify homeless families by stabilizing the mother in permanent housing and wrapping her
	with support and sevices that make it safe for her children to come home. The SCFC has been and continues
	to be actively engaged in three areas of work (chronic, youth, and families) to end homelessness.
