Ever y three years, the Association hires an outside independent consultant who reviews all sta ff position descriptions and benchmark data compiled from other Association compensation data from similar organizations. Following this review, the consultant provides salary rang es for each member of the Association staff. Ranges for the Executive Director and key emp loyees are shared with the Executive Committee to provide the necessary framework to make compensation decisions. The Executive Committee also receives comparative compensation data a for CEO/Executive Director and all other relevant positions that has been compiled by the American Society of Association Executives (national data), and their local chapter, the Association Forum of Chicago. Formal meeting minutes of the Executive Committee's deliber ations are compiled and filed.
