UCare operates a health maintenance organization (HMO) providing coordinated health care and coverage for over 152,183 individuals from the community enrolled in state public programs, federal Medicare Advantage programs, and Misure marketplace plans, including Medicaid and Medicare, and indivudual and family policies UCare's programs provide services to seniors, low-income families, those with physical disabililities and other individuals who may have challenges accessing health care. UCare also serves those seeking individual and family plan coverage through Mnsure UCare's mission is to improve the health of our members through innovative services and partnerships across communities In 2016, UCare's quality monitoring and program initiatives demonstrated many significant activities and outcomes. The highlights are outlined as follows, -Statistically significant (p>0 05) clinical improvements for our members were identified in the following Healthcare Effectiveness Data and Information Set ("HEDIS") measurements for Medicare and Medicaid Controlling High Blood Pressure, HbA1c Control for Diabetes, Asthma Medication Adherence, Annual Monitoring for Members on Persistent Medications, and Medication Reconciliation Post Discharge Beyond HEDIS measures, statistically significant improvement was observed in Medication Adherence for Diabetes, Statins, and Hypertension Medications -UCare's health improvement efforts also were reflected in 2016 by earning 4.5 stars out of 5 in the CMS Medicare Performance Assessment report for its UCare for Seniors product and 3.5 for the Minnesota Senior Health Options product UCare provides many health promotion. disease management, care management and wellness programs. These efforts not only benefit the health of its enrollees, but positively affect their families and larger communities Examples include disease management programs for asthma, diabetes, chronic kidney disease and congestive heart failure, falls prevention programs to improve safety of seniors, Management of Maternity Services (M O M S ) programs that provide resources to enrollees and providers to improve pregnancy and post-partum health, car seat distribution and education to pregnant women, and distribution of free materials on health education and proper use of urgent and emergency facilities at community forums. In addition UCare supports member health with access to many different fitness options as well as discounts on services that are health and wellness related but may not be covered by the members plan, including alternative medicine and community education. UCare's Mobile Dental Clinic, operated with the University of Minnesota's School of Dentistry, offers quality oral health care to UCare members with dental access issues From September-December 2016, the MDC staff performed 692 preventive and restorative procedures for more than 277 members at nine sites in Minnesota UCare health plan employees also devoted time to participate in collaborations that support efforts to improve health care quality and advance public health and health care access, including projects aimed at reducing language and cultural barriers Examples of organizations and collaborations with which our employees worked include Community Health Worker Project, Institute for Clinical Systems Improvement, Minnesota Community Measurement, Health Literacy Partnership, Interpreter Stakeholders Group, Metro and Minnesota Public Health Association/Health Plan Collaboration, and the Multilingual Health Resource Exchange
