Article 7:

- (a) The purposes for which the corporation is organized are exclusively charitable, religious educational and scientific purposes, all within the meaning of Code Section 501(c)(3), including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Code Section 501(c)(3).
- No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in these Articles of Incorporation. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Code section 501(c)(3) or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible for income, estate and gift tax purposes under Code sections 170(c)(2), 2055(a)(2) and 2522(a)(2).
- (c) Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3). Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Circuit Court of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

- (e) All references in this Articles of Incorporation to Code sections are to sections of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, and shall include future amendments to such sections and corresponding provisions of future federal tax laws, all as from time to time in effect.
