Statement 17

Lannan Foundation produces the very popular Readings & Conversations series that brings nationally and internationally recognized poets and writers to Santa Fe, New Mexico to read and discuss their work in a public setting. The series begins each September and runs through June of the following year. A typical Readings & Conversations evening lasts for about 2 hours, with the poet or writer reading from his or her work and then having a conversation with another writer, poet, editor, publisher or literary figure. The Community Outreach component of Lannan's public program series distributes between 100 and 200 tickets to students and teachers free of charge for each event. In addition, nearly three-quarters of the visiting authors will make a classroom visit, talking directly with students and teachers about their work. There were six Readings & Conversations events in 2016.

All events are audio-taped and video-taped. The audio and video recordings of each event are available within 7- 10 days in the audio archive area of Lannan Foundation's website, www.lannan.org, as well as on numerous public media sites such as YouTube. Well over 5,000 tickets are distributed to attendees of the live events each year, and hundreds of thousands of visits are made to the Foundation website annually.

Statement 18

In Pursuit of Cultural Freedom – a lecture series on political, economic, environmental, and human rights issues featuring social justice activists, writers, journalists, and scholars discussing critical topics of our day, continues to be successful. The "In Pursuit of Cultural Freedom" series takes place in Santa Fe, New Mexico, and the series begins each September and runs through May of the following year. The lectures begin with a speaker who gives a talk on his or her topic for about 45 minutes, followed by a conversation with an interlocutor for 30 minutes.

The series is presented at downtown Santa Fe's beautiful Lensic Performing Arts Center, with a seating capacity of 800. All events have been full or near to full capacity in attendance, and community outreach tickets are offered at no charge to hundreds of local students and teachers as well. Lannan often makes the speakers' books available to students and teachers as part of its Community Outreach program effort, and some of the speakers make visits to one or more local school classrooms while in Santa Fe to discuss their work directly with students and teachers. There were six "In Pursuit of Cultural Freedom" lectures in 2016.

As with our Readings & Conversations public program, all events are audio-taped and videotaped.

Statement 19

The Exhibition Program was established to support the creation of new work and to give greater exposure to contemporary artists. In 1981 J. Patrick Lannan, Sr. founded the Lannan Museum in Lake Worth, Florida. Housed in a renovated Art Deco movie theatre, the museum building was designed to provide an environment for the presentation of selections from the collection as well as temporary exhibitions. Artists presented at the Lannan Museum included Greg Colson, Kathy Muehlemann, Ed Ruscha, and James Turrell.

After the foundation relocated to Los Angeles in July 1990, new galleries were inaugurated with presentations of paintings by German artist Gerhard Richter and a monumental sculpture, *The Tables*, by New York-based artist Tom Otterness. Subsequent exhibitions included work by artists Siah Armajani, Chris Burden, Chuck Close, Lynn Davis, Robert Frank, Gary Simmons, and Bill Viola among a number of thematic group presentations.

The current Exhibition Program in Santa Fe presents between one and three exhibitions per year. Exhibitions are free and open to the public for individual visits, as well as those by schools, clubs, and other groups. This year was exceptional in that four exhibitions were presented to the public in 2016. The exhibition A Visit with Old Friends was open January 30 to March 6, 2016 and had an attendance of 320 visitors. The following exhibition was Lucky 13: New Mexico School for the Arts Graduating Seniors Exhibition on view from April 29 to May 15, 2016 with an attendance of 420 people. Next was (Infra) Structure: complex, below and further on and was open to the public from July 16 to August 29, 2017 with a total attendance of 525. The final exhibition was UCROSS: A Portrait in Place, on view from October 22 to December 11, 2016 with a total attendance of 560.

Statement 20

The Lannan Writing Residency Fellowship provides uninterrupted writing time for poets, writers, essayists, translators, scholars and curators, as well as indigenous, environmental and social justice activists. Residency durations are usually from four to six weeks, and residency fellows often give readings open to the public at no charge.

Since the fall of 2000, more than 320 residency fellows have been housed in Lannan properties in Marfa, Texas, a small, beautiful, high desert ranching town in West Texas near the Chinati Mountains to the southwest and the Davis Mountains to the northeast. Marfa is also home to the internationally known Chinati Foundation, a contemporary art organization founded by the late sculptor, Donald Judd. Lannan Foundation residencies have provided creative inspiration for an untold number of published works of fiction, poetry and nonfiction, and other works of art.

Candidates for the residency program are selected through an internal nomination process. Unsolicited applications are not accepted.
