

The consultant prepares a detailed report with recommendations for pay and/or benefit adjustments, and presents the information to the executive committee of the Board of Directors (when the CEOs survey data and recommendations are presented, the CEO and staff are excused from the deliberations). After all questions of the Board members are answered, formal motions are proposed, seconded and voted on (for any pay adjustments and for receipt of the consultants report). At the subsequent meetin g of the full Board of Directors, the Chair presents recommendations of the Executive Committee, and the full Board acts on a formal motion that is seconded and voted on
