Over 1,000 boys and girls participated in youth sports leagues and clinics. Gymnastics had over 500 youth take part in classes and open gym YMCA financial assistance. The YMCA works with area schools, churches, social workers and other united way agencies to help identify youth, adults or families. who need YMCA experiences through memberships and programs. Although we charge fees for service based upon cost of providing these services, we maintain a policy of never turning away a person because of inability to pay. All scholarships are administered on a sliding fee basis following a personal interview with YMCA staff. In 2016, over 5,500 individuals were members at the YMCA.
