Donations are forwarded to designated human service 501(c)3 agencies. Take-Along Food Program: Expenses - \$11,097 - United Way of Mahaska County's Take-Along Weekend Food Program provides bags of meals, snacks and drinks to students who struggle with food insecurity over the weekend. Each Friday during the school year, the program serves 50 children at Oskaloosa Elementary and 25 children at Oskaloosa Middle School. Operation Backpack/Stuff the Bus: Expenses - \$6,487 - Each summer, United Way of Mahaska County sponsors Stuff the Bus, a school supply drive to gather supplies for Operation Backpack. Operation Backpack provides school supplies to Mahaska County children in low income families. Any child or youth (preschool through 12th grade) residing in Mahaska County is eligible for the program. In 2016, we supplied over 400 backpacks to families in need. Leftover school supplies were given to local schools to stock school supply closets, which can be utilized by teachers throughout the school year. We partnered with SIEDA, Salvation Army and the school districts in Mahaska County. Color Me United 5K & YMCA Healthy Kids Day: Expenses - \$4,116 - The Color Me United 5K & YMCA Healthy Kids Day is an opportunity to promote health and wellness each spring. The color run is followed by free activities, like inflatables and sports, and booths with information about healthy living initiatives in our community. Proceeds in 2016 went to support lowa Reading Corps. Volunteer Center: Expenses - \$2,129 - United Way of Mahaska County operates a Volunteer Center in Mahaska County. Local agencies are able to post volunteer needs on the Volunteer Center website. Community members can access the website to find volunteer opportunities that match their interests and availability. The Volunteer Center coordinated many volunteers for the Oskaloosa Summer Lunch Program in 2016. Day of Caring: Expenses - \$1,708 - United Way of Mahaska County empowers volunteers in our community to come together to assist in completing projects for those in our community that might not otherwise be completed. We organize volunteers to work on a variety of projects each year, including those that serve seniors and individuals with disabilities, city and county projects, local non-profit agencies and schools. In 2016, we completed 16 projects with approximately 201 volunteers. Special Grants: Expenses - \$1,500 (including grants of \$1,500) - United Way of Mahaska County provided Special Grants to one local agency in Mahaska County.
