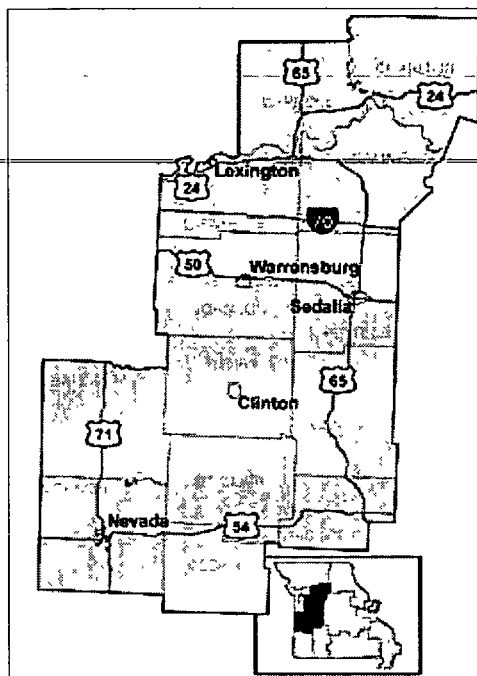

THE COST APPROACH: Within this approach land value was estimated to be \$37,000 or 4% of the total estimated value by this approach. Land value was estimated by comparison. The improvement value was based on replacement cost estimated by the appraiser using data derived from the Marshall and Swift Valuation Services. The subject improvements are in good condition constructed of good quality materials with a functional design and no external inadequacies noted. The Cost Approach is considered the best indicator of value for a subject type property. Subject is a special purpose property that is complimentary to the local community needs and constructed for the special dog and cat kennel use.

SALES COMPARISON APPROACH: This approach is typically considered one of the best approaches to value as it is an actual measure of actions in the marketplace between buyers and sellers. However, subject type specials use properties are not marketable and therefore, the Sales Comparison Approach is not used.

THE INCOME APPROACH: The subject property is not leased. Rental income data from dog and cat kennels was not found in the subjects greater market area. Therefore the Income Capitalization Approach is not used.
