**PART II - Line 17b**

This is the 6th year for the Corban Broadcasting Inc organization. This organization produces a non-profit, non-commercial Christian radio station airing 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Daily programming consists of twenty-two hours of classic Christian music and two hours of family interest / community news and encourages family values and good citizenship. Programming may be heard in homes and cars, in offices and businesses, and in nursing homes and public facilities.

Corban Broadcasting Inc is governed by a diverse board of directors consisting of one pastor, one small business owner, one sole proprietor one tax professional, one active military, and one homemaker. Two of these directors live in the home community of the radio station, two live in the home state - one rural and one urban - but outside of the listening area, and two live well outside of the listening area in another state.

With the vision and encouragment of this board of directors, Corban Broadcasting Inc. began maintaining a website and streaming online in May 2016, expanding from a potential 300,000 listeners to a global audience, receiving responses from over 20 states and 10 foreign countries. The Board promotes public awareness and fundraising through personal contact, speaking engagements, periodic newsletters, email, social media, the webpage, and local church-sponsored events.

Because of the efforts of dedicated volunteers, the revenues for Corban Broadcasting Inc. have grown from \$8787 and 55 contributors in 2012 to annual gross receipts of \$21,233 in 2016 with a total of 146 different contributors. Donations have been received from 18 public charities / church groups, 5 businesses, and the remainder from the general public. Most single contributions are \$25-\$100, and most of the contributions in excess of 2% come from regular donors whose annual total is only about \$350-\$500. Only 12 gifts have been \$1000 or more. In 2016 Corban Broadcasting Inc received a single gift of \$6,250 as noted on Schedule B.
