	with elected officials to implement the new satellite voting stations. Our outreach program is designed to ensure that every Native
	American who wishes to vote and engage with elected officials can do so without unnecessary barriers.

	Polling: We began a first-of-its-kind poll of Montana Native Americans to gauge community attitudes toward civic engagement,

	Montana.

	staff support for one-on-one consultation with potential enrollees and then connected them to navigators and certified application
