We also conduct conferences and seminars to encourage and equip individuals to participate in evangelism and to serve others at home and abroad. Training and livestock, such as pigs and goats are provided for families to continue farming and raising livestock to provide income and food in Uganda, Haiti and India. Expense: 8355 **Health & Welfare Services:** During Journeys of Compassion and to assist in providing needed health and welfare benefits, we set up medical clinics to deal with chronic diseases such as digestive problems due to unsafe drinking water and lack of food. We provide meals for slum areas in India and for the orphanage in Haiti. Mosquito nets are provided to Uganda to assist with disease prevention.
