CORPORATION. THE CORPORATION'S ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION WERE AMENDED TO EXPAND THE CORPORATION'S PURPOSES TO INCLUDE RELIGIOUS PURPOSES AND THE OPERATION OF A CHRISTIAN EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION, TO DESCRIBE THE APPROVAL REQUIRED TO AMEND CERTAIN OF THE CORPORATION'S KEY POLICIES AND STATEMENTS, AND TO UPDATE THE NON-DISCRIMINATION LANGUAGE TO ENSURE CONSISTENCY WITH THE CORPORATION'S ANTICIPATED OPERATIONS AND NON-DISCRIMINATION POLICY, WHICH WAS ADOPTED SHORTLY THEREAFTER.

THE BYLAWS WERE AMENDED TO: (A) ELIMINATE THE LIMIT ON THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF DIRECTORS CONSTITUTING THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS; (B) SPECIFY THE APPROVAL REQUIRED FOR CERTAIN CORPORATE ACTIONS, INCLUDING ANY AMENDMENT OF THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION, BYLAWS, OR FOUNDATIONAL DOCUMENTS OF THE CORPORATION; (C) ESTABLISH THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE AND DESCRIBE THE COMPOSITION, POWERS, AND MEMBERSHIP OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE AND OTHER COMMITTEES ESTABLISHED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS; (D) PROVIDE THAT A DIRECTOR HAVING A CONFLICT OF INTEREST MAY BE COUNTED IN DETERMINING WHETHER A QUORUM IS PRESENT FOR THE VOTE ON THE MATTER; (E) ELIMINATE A REQUIREMENT FOR BOARD APPROVAL OF CERTAIN PURCHASES; (F) ALLOW THE BOARD TO ADOPT A SEPARATE CONFLICT OF INTEREST POLICY; (G) ELIMINATE THE OFFICES OF THE PRESIDENT AND THE TREASURER; (H) ESTABLISH THE OFFICES OF THE CHAIR, SUPERINTENDENT, AND CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER AND DESCRIBE THEIR RESPECTIVE ELECTION OR APPOINTMENT, TERMS, RIGHTS, DUTIES, AND RESIGNATION OR REMOVAL; (I) PROVIDE THAT CERTAIN OF THE OFFICERS MAY RECEIVE REASONABLE COMPENSATION FOR THEIR SERVICE AS OFFICERS AND THAT OFFICERS MAY RECEIVE REASONABLE COMPENSATION FOR PERFORMANCE OF CERTAIN PERSONAL SERVICES RENDERED TO THE CORPORATION; (J) AUTHORIZE AND EMPOWER CERTAIN OFFICERS TO EXECUTE DOCUMENTS ON THE CORPORATION'S BEHALF; AND (K) PERMIT THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS TO DELEGATE ANY POWERS OR DUTIES OF AN OFFICER TO ANOTHER OFFICER OR A DIRECTOR.
