	provided cost-share financial assistance to 61 private landowners that addressed pollutants that affect the water quality of the
	watersheds. Pollutants reduced include sediments, nutrients, bacteria, livestock waste which affects public drinking water supplies
	in the lakes. These programs assist with extending the storage capacity of the reservoirs and restores the quality of public
	drinking water.
