A majority of the Foundation's trustees also constitute a majority of the trustees of Clayton. The presence of this common supervision and control among their respective governing bodies ensures both that the Foundation will be responsive to the needs and requirements of Clayton and that the control and management of the Foundation is vested in the same persons that control and manage Clayton.
