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Strengthening the Inter American Human Rights System This program monitors the OAS on human rights issues and carries out applied research, advocacy activities, and promotes informed dialogue amongst users of the OAS's IAHRs to promote continuation of the system's legacy and its relevance to current realities. In 2016, DPLF studied and promoted the use of international (UN, OAS and IAHRs) Ad Hoc mechanisms to address impunity and corruption in the Americas, such as the CICIG in Guatemala, GIEI in Mexico (Ayotzinapa case), and the MACCIH in Honduras. An English version of our 2015 book Challenges of the Inter American Human Rights System: New Times, Old Challenges was launched and we disseminated a number of info-graphics addressing civil society participation in and understanding of the MACCIH, international law and the fight against impunity, and the ideal profile for a new Executive Secretary of the IACHR.
