Only disinterested members of the Executive Committee may participate in any review. The Executive Committee shall inform the Board of its determination and recommended action. The Board shall retain the right to modify or reverse such determination and action, and shall retain the ultimate enforcement authority with respect to the interpretation and application of this policy. With respect to any potential conflict of interest involving key employees, the President and CEO of USTelecom with appropriate consultation, shall determine whether such conflict exists and what is the appropriate remedy and shall exerc ise its authority with respect to the review of that decision or may refer it to the full Board of Directors.
