THE JOHN LENNOX FILM PROJECT IS AN EDUCATIONAL DOCUMENTARY MOVIE PRODUCTION EXAMINING THE LIFE AND SCHOLARSHIP OF UNIVERSITY OF OXFORD MATHEMATICS PROFESSOR JOHN C. LENNOX, PHD, DSC, DPHIL, FOCUSING ON HIS ANALYSIS OF THE INTERSECTION BETWEEN SCIENCE AND THE CHRISTIAN WORLDVIEW. THE FILM WILL EXPLORE HIS CHILDHOOD, YOUTH, EDUCATION, TEACHING CAREER, AND ESPECIALLY HIS TRAVELS AND LECTURES AROUND THE WORLD ON SCIENCE'S RELATIONSHIP TO THE BIBLICAL ACCOUNT OF THE CREATION OF LIFE AND THE UNIVERSE.

THE FILM WILL SERVE TO EDUCATE THE PUBLIC ON NOT ONLY DR. LENNOX'S LIFE AND WORK, BUT ALSO ON THE ISSUES SURROUNDING WHAT IS OFTEN PERCEIVED TO BE AN ADVERSARIAL RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THEISM AND THE SCIENTIFIC WORLDVIEW. AFTER VIEWING THE FILM THE PUBLIC WILL HAVE RECEIVED A THOROUGH FAMILIARIZATION WITH THE MOST PERTINENT ISSUES AND ARGUMENTS SURROUNDING THIS TOPIC. THESE ISSUES INCLUDE CONSIDERATIONS ON THE HISTORY AND PHILOSOPHY OF SCIENCE, THE LAW-LIKE MATHEMATICAL DESCRIPTION OF NATURAL SCIENCE, THE LANGUAGE-LIKE NATURE OF INFORMATION ENCODED IN THE DNA OF LIVING ORGANISMS, THE SENSE OF MORALITY INHERENT TO MANKIND AND WHETHER MODERN SCIENCE AND A BIBLICAL WORLDVIEW ARE IN CONFLICT.

THE FOUNDATION HAS BEEN IN COMMUNICATION WITH 44 CHRISTIAN MINISTRIES AND ORGANIZATIONS, INCLUDING THE WORLD EVANGELICAL ALLIANCE, WHICH COUNTS OVER 600MILLION EVANGELICAL CHRISTIANS THAT IT SERVES WORLDWIDE, THAT COULD BE INSTURMENTAL IN DISTRIBUTING THE FINISHED FILM AND SPREADING THE NEWS OF THE FILM AMONG THEIR NETWORKS AND CONSTITUANTS.

THE FILM WILL BE MADE AVAILABLE THROUGH MULTIPLE CHANNELS BUT ESPECIALLY AT UNIVERSITIES, CONFERENCES AND PUBLIC EVENTS WHERE PROF. LENNOX CAN NO LONGER APPEAR IN PERSON DUE TO HEALTH AND SCHEDULE ISSUES. THE EDUCATIONAL AND SCIENTIFIC PURPOSES OF THE DOCUMENTARY ARE IN ADHERENCE WITH AND ADVANCE THE CHARITABLE MISSION OF THE FOUNDATION.
