EXPENDITURE RESPONSIBILITY AGREEMENT

AGREEMENT made the 19th day of August , 2016 , by and between the **The From Him and Through Him Foundation** (the "Foundation") and **The Toby Cassels Foundation** (the "Grantee"). The Foundation has agreed to make a grant of \$500,000 to the Grantee to **be used to fund charitable purposes**, subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. Grant Payments.

- a. <u>Amount of Grant</u>. The Foundation will make a grant of \$500,000 (the "Grant") to the Grantee, to be used solely for the purposes set forth in this Agreement.
- b. <u>Timing of Payment</u>. The full Grant will be paid to the Grantee within 30 days after the Foundation's receipt of the signed original of this Agreement.

2. Use of Grant Funds.

- a. <u>The Fund</u>. All Grant funds shall be held and, until all Grant funds have been expended, continuously maintained by the Grantee in a separate fund, to be known as the **Charitable Purpose** Fund (the "Fund"). The principal of the Fund and the income and appreciation derived from the investment of the Fund shall be used solely for the charitable purposes authorized by this Agreement.
- b. <u>Grant Purposes</u>. Distributions shall be made from the Fund solely to support charitable purposes, as further described in the Grantee's grant proposal dated August 19, 2016 (the "Grant Proposal"), attached hereto as "Exhibit A."
- c. [Distributions Out of Corpus: The Grantee agrees to expend all of the Grant funds so as to enable the Foundation to count the grant as a qualifying distribution within the meaning of Section 4942(g)(3) of the Code, therefore agreeing to expend all Grant funds for charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 170(c)(2)(B) of the Code no later than the end of the Grantee's first taxable year after the taxable year in which the Grant funds are received, and to make such other expenditures as to ensure that the payment of the Grant funds is treated as having been made out of corpus within the meaning of Section 4942(g)(3) of the Code, neither reporting undistributed income within the meaning of Section 4942(c) of the Code, nor counting the expenditure of the Grant funds as a qualifying distribution.]²
- 3. Acknowledgments and Privacy. The Grantee agrees that payment of the Grant by the Foundation shall be recognized in all appropriate annual reports, journals, bulletins, catalogues and announcements, press releases, electronic materials and other publications by the Grantee. Unless approved in advance in writing by the Foundation, however, the Grantee shall

not disclose any specific terms or conditions of this Agreement, except for disclosures required to be made by law.

4. Reporting and Record-Keeping Requirements.

- a. The Grantee shall, within 60 days after the end of each fiscal year during which Grant funds have been retained or expended, deliver to the Foundation a written narrative and financial report regarding the use of the Grant funds and the progress that the Grantee has made toward accomplishing the charitable purposes of the Grant during such fiscal year. Additionally, the Grantee shall, within 60 days after the end of the fiscal year during which the use of the Grants funds is completed, deliver to the Foundation a final written narrative and financial report regarding the use of all Grant funds and the progress that the Grantee made toward accomplishing the charitable purposes of the Grant. Such reports shall be in the form attached hereto as Exhibit [B], and shall be supplemented by financial statements showing the value of all Grant funds and records of receipts (including, without limitation, the income and appreciation of the Fund) and expenditures of the Grant funds, and shall be attested to by the Grantee's responsible financial officer.
- b. The Grantee shall provide the Foundation with copies of all reports, publications and other materials prepared in connection with the Grant.
- c. The Grantee shall respond promptly to all reasonable requests from the Foundation for information relating to the Grant.
- d. Records of all receipts and expenditures under the Grant, as well as copies of all reports furnished to the Foundation, shall be kept available by the Grantee for inspection by the Foundation for a period of not less than four years after all Grant funds have been expended or, if an audit has been initiated and audit findings have not been resolved at the end of such four-year period, such records shall be retained until resolution of all audit findings.

5. Termination of Grant.

- a. The Foundation, in its sole discretion, and without regard to any commitments that the Grantee may have made to its employees or to third parties in connection with the Grant, may terminate the Grant at any time if the Grantee fails to satisfy any term or condition of this Agreement and if, after receiving notice from the Foundation of such failure, the Grantee fails to satisfy such term or condition within 30 days after receiving such notice.
- b. Upon termination of the Grant, the Grantee must return to the Foundation (i) all Grants funds (including all income and appreciation from such funds) that remain unspent and (ii) an amount equal to all Grant funds (including all income and appreciation from such funds) that were expended for purposes other than those authorized in this Agreement.

6. Prohibited Uses of Grant.

a. No part of the Grant shall be used (i) for other than charitable purposes (within the meaning of Section 170(c)(2)(B) of the Code, (ii) to carry on propaganda

or otherwise attempt to influence legislation (within the meaning of Section 4945(d)(1) of the Code) or (iii) to attempt to influence the outcome of any specific public election or to carry on, directly or indirectly, any voter registration drive (within the meaning of Section 4945(d)(2) of the Code).

- b. No part of the Grant shall be used to make a grant to any organization or entity, whether or not formed by the Grantee, or to any individual, unless such grant (i) is specifically set forth in the Grant Proposal or has been approved, in writing, by the Foundation and (ii) meets the applicable requirements of Section 4945 of the Code relating to expenditure responsibility grants and grants to individuals for travel, study or other similar purposes.
- c. The Grantee certifies that it is in compliance with all applicable laws restricting U.S. persons from dealing with any individuals, entities or groups subject to sanctions by the U.S. Department of the Treasury's Office of Foreign Assets Control ("OFAC"), and that it does not deal with any individuals, entities or groups subject to sanctions by OFAC or with any other persons known to the Grantee to support terrorism or to have violated OFAC sanctions. Additionally, the Grantee agrees that it will take all reasonable steps to ensure that the Grant is not used to support terrorist activity.
- d. The Grantee agrees that it will not incur any liabilities in reliance on the Grant until funds are received from the Foundation, unless specifically approved in writing by the Foundation.

7. Enforcement and Governing Law.

- a. Notwithstanding anything herein, the Foundation reserves the right to enforce any and all of the terms of this Agreement, including by filing suit in a court of competent jurisdiction. The Grantee agrees that it will not object to or challenge the standing of the Foundation to bring any such suit.
- b. Each of the parties to this Agreement acknowledges that the execution and delivery of this Agreement has been authorized by its governing body and, as a result, this Agreement shall bind and inure to the benefit of the respective parties to this Agreement, and their successors, heirs, distributees, executors and administrators. In addition, all rights and powers granted to the Foundation pursuant to the provisions of this Agreement shall, in the event that the Foundation is not then in existence, be exercisable by the Foundation's Designated Representatives, as hereinafter defined, and all references in this Agreement to the Foundation shall, in the event that the Foundation is not then in existence, be deemed to be references to the Foundation's Designated Representatives.
- c. For purposes of this Agreement, the Foundation's "Designated Representatives" shall mean the following: (i) such one or more individuals or entities designated in writing by the Trustees of the Foundation or by any previously acting Designated Representative, provided, however, that if more than one such conflicting designations are then in existence, the most recent designation shall govern or, if no such individual or entity has been

designated and the Foundation is no longer in existence, (ii) the last acting Trustee or Trustees of the Foundation.

- d. The laws of the State of South Carolina shall govern all matters arising under or relating to this Agreement.
- 8. Waiver. Notwithstanding anything herein to the contrary, any term or condition of this Agreement may be waived at any time by the party that is entitled to the benefit thereof, but no such waiver shall be effective unless set forth in a written instrument duly executed by or on behalf of the party waiving such term or condition. No failure or delay of any party hereto to enforce at any time any provision of this Agreement, and no act, omission or course of dealing between the parties (i) shall be construed to be a waiver of such provision or an estoppel of any right, remedy or condition under this Agreement or (ii) shall in any way affect the validity of this Agreement or any part hereof or the right of any party thereafter to enforce each and every provision of this Agreement. No waiver by any party of any term or condition of this Agreement, in any one or more instances, shall be deemed to be or construed as a waiver of the same or any other term or condition of this Agreement on any future occasion.
- 9. <u>References to the Code</u>: All references in this Agreement to the "Code" shall be deemed to be references to the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended from time to time, and shall include corresponding provisions of all subsequently enacted federal tax laws.
- 10. <u>Amendment</u>. The terms of this Agreement may be amended only by a written instrument that is identified as an amendment hereto and is signed by the Foundation and the Grantee.
- 11. <u>Partial Invalidity</u>. In the event that any term or provision, of this Agreement is declared illegal, void or unenforceable, it shall not affect or impair the other terms and provisions of this Agreement. The doctrine of severability shall be applied.
- 12. <u>PDF and Counterparts</u>. This Agreement may be executed by "PDF" and in one or more counterparts, each of which when so executed and delivered will be deemed an original, but all of which together will constitute one and the same original.
- 13. <u>Entire Agreement</u>. This Agreement constitutes the final and entire agreement between the Foundation and the Grantee.

In consideration of the mutual obligations and covenants set forth in this Agreement, the Grantee and the Foundation hereby accept and agree to the foregoing terms and conditions of this Agreement.
