Nemours' clinical operations in Florida include a children's hospital in Orlando, and a statewide physician practice with campuses in Jacksonville, Pensacola and Orlando. The majority of children and youth in Florida are white (67.6%) while African American children make up 21% of the population (US Census Bureau, 2011). A slightly larger number of children and youth in Florida (24.9%) live below 100% of the FPL when compared to the national rate of children in poverty (22.5%). Based on the US Census bureau (2011), children in Florida are more likely to be uninsured or publicly insured (53.1%), and less likely to be privately insured


