The school is located in a low-income neighborhood and the tutoring services are available for each of the approximately 100 students in the adopted class. None of the students in the adopted class are family members of a "disqualified person" with respect to the Foundation. Individuals provide the tutoring services for the students at the school and the Foundation pays for the tutoring services on behalf of the students.

# A STATEMENT ATTACHED TO AND MADE PART OF FORM 990-PF RETURN OF PRIVATE FOUNDATION

JBJ Foundation was created in April 2000 for the purpose of promoting and fostering the education of under-privileged youth. In general, the Foundation is an "I Have a Dream" Program sponsor.

In May 2000, the Foundation "adopted" the entire first grade class of Charles Drew Elementary School in Liberty City, Florida. Currently, 89 students known as "Dreamers" are sponsored in the program. Since the "adoption," the Foundation continues to provide various activities in furtherance of its exempt purposes of fostering the education of the students, including the following:

- Mentoring assistance to help students through college.
- Assistance to students who are still in high school.
- Book club monthly meetings for students still in the Miami area and students in Miami during the book club meetings (during the summer, and school breaks).
- Meetings are held during the summer to ensure progress towards completion of college for out of town students.
- Tuition assistance for every Dreamer that gains admission to a two or four year accredited college or university as outlined specifically in the sponsorship agreement documents.
- In 2011, the Charles Drew Elementary School's first grade class adopted in 2000 graduated high school. The Foundation is providing tuition assistance of up to \$2,500 per year for every member that gained admission to a two or four year accredited college or university. The Foundation also helps with some accredited vocational/technical school tuition.
- In 2016, 32 students were attending college or university, including vocational/technical school, 31 graduated college, 3 were in the military, and 10 were idle (no present scholarship interest).

In addition to the Foundation directors, the Foundation employs a Project Coordinator that arranges for all tutoring, events, workshops, and programs.
