- d To develop a communications and information network that fosters ties between the local United Way and the community by listening to the community as well as informing the community of the programs available,

and to further a communications network that offers an exchange of information and ideas among all funded agencies

- e To organize and operate a systematic program for distributing funds raised in the United Way campaigns, to develop ways to include in the distribution plan those organizations which have not been funded before, to reduce or discontinue funding to those organizations that are no longer relevant to community needs, to provide for donor involvement in the fund distribution program, and to provide giving options to the donor
- f To receive by gift, grant, devise, bequest and otherwise and from any private or public sources, personal or real property, and to hold, administer, sell, invest, reinvest, manage, use, disburse and distribute, and apply the income and/or principal of the same in accordance with the directions and intent of the donor, as the Corporation may deem best from time to time, for the promotion of any or all of the foregoing purposes
- g To do any and all things, either alone or in cooperation with other organizations or institutions, and either directly or by contribution to such other organizations or institutions which it may deem necessary or proper in order to carry into effect any or all of the foregoing objects or purposes

SECTION 22

Nothing herein shall authorize this Corporation, organized as a not-for-profit corporation under the laws of the State of Oklahoma, directly or indirectly to engage in or include among its purposes, any activities prohibited by state law

SECTION 2.3

No substantial part of the activities of this Corporation shall be for the purpose of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation in violation of federal guidelines. None of the activities of this Corporation shall consist of participating in, or intervening in (including the publishing or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

SECTION 24

No part of the net earnings of this Corporation shall inure to the benefit of any private shareholder or any individual. The property of this Corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable purposes, and upon liquidation, dissolution or abandonment of the owner, after providing for the debts and obligations thereof, the remaining assets will not inure to the benefit of any private person but will be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes and which has established its tax-exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) and 509 (a)(1), (2) or (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986

ARTICLE III Members

SECTION 3 1

The Members of this Corporation shall be one class termed "Members"

SECTION 3 2

Each contributor to the United Way of Payne County, Incorporated shall be a Member for the year in which such contribution is credited

SECTION 33

Each Member shall be entitled to one vote on all matters presented at a meeting of the Members. There shall be no cumulative voting or voting by proxy. Unless otherwise provided by law or by these by-laws, a majority of the votes cast shall govern in every election and matter voted upon.

SECTION 34

Organizations or entities receiving funding from or through the Corporation may be referred to as "Member Agencies" or "Member Organizations" but they are not thereby "Members" with the meaning of these by-laws

ARTICLE IV Board of Directors

SECTION 4 1

The management of this Corporation shall be vested in a Board of Directors consisting of not less than twenty-five (25) members nor more than thirty-seven (37) directors, eleven (11) of whom shall be elected each year for a term of three (3) years at the annual meeting of Members in order that there be staggered terms. The Immediate Past President and chairs of Standing Committees who are not already serving on the Board of Directors shall be <u>ex-officio</u> members with vote in addition to the thirty-three provided above. No person may serve on the Board for more than six (6) consecutive years except that additional terms for up to six (6) consecutive years may be served when each is separated by one year of absence from membership on the Board

SECTION 42

Not later than the first day of December of each year, the Executive Committee shall appoint a Nominating Committee consisting of seven (7) persons of whom four (4) shall be from the Board and three (3) from the individual membership. The Nominating Committee shall select nominees for Directors and Officers who will make the Board representative of the various interests in the community.

SECTION 43

The United Way of Payne County Board of Directors may declare a position vacant if the Director shall have missed three (3) consecutive meetings

SECTION 4 4

The United Way of Payne County Board of Directors shall fill any vacancy occurring in the Board of Directors using the following procedure—when a vacancy occurs for any reason, the Executive Committee shall nominate a new director, who shall then be approved by a majority vote of the entire Board of Directors—The new director shall serve out the remainder of the unexpired term of the former director he or she is replacing

SECTION 45

In addition to the duties and powers otherwise delegated to the Board of Directors in these by-laws, the duties and powers of the Board of Directors shall be

- a To manage the affairs of this organization between meetings of the Members thereof
- b To adopt such policies and procedures for the operation of this organization as may be consistent with these by-laws, and designed to carry out the objects of this organization
- c To appoint such committees as it may deem expedient for the carrying out of the objects of this organization
- d To arrange for the raising of funds
- To control the distribution of funds collected
- f To employ such persons as it may deem necessary for the successful prosecution of the objects of this organization
- g To give at least once a year a full and complete report of its activities at a meeting of the Members of the organization
- h To appoint, for one year, ex-officio, such honorary non-voting members to the Board of Directors and/or such non-voting honorary officers, not to exceed five, whose association with the United Way of Payne County, Incorporated, may be expected to benefit the relationship of the United Way to the community

- To approve appointment of not more than six additional Directors to the Board of Directors for a one year term as recommended by the Executive Committee
- J An honorary life membership may be granted to an individual by vote of the Board of Directors Recognition may be given at the annual meeting

ARTICLE V Officers

SECTION 5 1

- a The officers of this Corporation shall be a President, a Presidentelect, a Vice President and a Treasurer, who shall be elected by the Board from its Directors
- b The Board may appoint or employ an Executive Director, who shall act as Secretary, and other personnel who shall be given such duties as the Board sees fit In the absence of the Executive Director, the Board shall elect a Secretary from among its Directors

SECTION 52

All officers are elected for terms of one year and serve until their successors are elected and qualified

SECTION 53

The duties of the Officers shall be

<u>President</u> - to preside at all meetings of Members and the Board of Directors, to appoint the Chairs of each Committee, to call special meetings when deemed necessary, and to carry out such other duties as usually pertain to this office

<u>President-elect</u> - to perform the duties of the President in the event the President is absent

<u>Vice-President</u> - to perform the duties of the President in the absence of both the President and President-elect
The Vice-President shall perform other duties as may be assigned from time-to-time by the Board

<u>Treasurer</u> - to have charge of all the funds of this Corporation and to make reports on transactions and the financial condition of the Corporation All authorized disbursements, other than by petty cash and monthly accounts set up on auto-pay, shall be made by checks signed by the Executive Director and countersigned by the

Treasurer, when available, otherwise by the President or President-elect All bills for monthly accounts set up on auto-pay will be reviewed and initialed on a monthly basis by the Executive Director and Treasurer In the absence of the Executive Director, checks shall be signed by the Treasurer and one of the other Officers All Officers and employees shall be bonded at the cost of the Corporation

ARTICLE VI Standing Committees

SECTION 6 1

The Standing Committees shall be the Executive Committee, Allocations Committee, Accreditation Committee, Publicity Committee, Policies and Procedures Committee and Campaign Committee

SECTION 62

- a The Executive Committee shall consist of the President, Presidentelect, Vice-President, Treasurer, Chairs of Standing Committees and the Immediate Past President
- b The Executive Committee shall supervise the transaction of all routine business of the Corporation and shall act for the Board in the interim between meetings of the Board. It shall have the authority to order disbursements of the necessary expenses of operating the Corporation and shall possess all other powers delegated to it by these by-laws or by the Board. The Executive Committee shall report its activities at each meeting.
- c The Executive Committee shall recommend to the Board the admission of Member Agencies pursuant to ARTICLE VII

SECTION 63

- a The Allocations Committee shall consist of a Chair and not less than nine (9) other directors, appointed by the Executive Committee
- b The Allocations Committee shall consider and recommend to the Board the policies of this Corporation in relation to Member Agencies, all matters pertaining to special appropriations, the budgets of all Member Agencies, their allowances, increases or decreases of budgets, and payments to Member Agencies in accordance with such policies and budget considerations. All acts of the Allocations Committee shall be subject to the final approval of the Board

SECTION 64

- a The Publicity Committee shall consist of a Chair and not less than five (5) other Directors, appointed by the Executive Committee
- b The Publicity Committee shall supervise and direct a continuous educational and publicity program subject to the approval of the Board This program shall be designed to inform the community concerning social needs and the services of the United Way of Payne County as well as the Member Agencies in order to encourage sound and intelligent support for such activities

SECTION 65

- a The Campaign Committee shall consist of a Chair and not less than five (5) other Directors, appointed by the Executive Committee, and the division chairs who are to be selected by the Chair and the Director members of the Campaign Committee
- b The Campaign Committee shall supervise and direct the annual campaign for funds subject to the supervision and direction of the Board

SECTION 66

- a The Accreditation Committee shall consist of a Chair and not less than four (4) other Directors, appointed by the Executive Committee
- b The Accreditation Committee shall administer the United Way's accreditation program under which each member Agency and each candidate for admission as a Member Agency will be reviewed in accordance with the policies of this Corporation relating to accreditation
- c The Accreditation Committee shall recommend accreditation for a Member Agency or candidate for admission as a Member Agency for a period of not less than two (2) nor more than five (5) years after each review and/or shall propose such other action as the Committee may deem appropriate under the circumstances (including loss of or denial of status as a Member Agency) All acts of the Accreditation Committee shall be subject to the final approval of the Board

SECTION 67

- a The Policy and Procedures committee shall consist of a chair and not less than 4 other directors appointed by the Executive Committee
- b The Policy and Procedures committee shall review the By-Laws, Code of Ethics, and Personnel Policy and Procedures This committee will also monitor and

update the Strategic/Long Range Plan and coordinate with the Finance Committee the review of the Financial Policies and Office Financial Safeguards

SECTION 68

The Board or the President may establish such other committees as deemed necessary or desirable for the accomplishment of the objectives of this Corporation Members of such committees may or may not be directors

ARTICLE VII Member Agencies

SECTION 7 1

- a To be eligible to become a Member Agency, the candidate for admission shall have received a determination that it is exempt from taxation under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or under the relevant provisions of any future Internal Revenue Code) and shall have conducted, for at least one year immediately preceding application for admission, a program of health, welfare, or other activity deemed by the Board to be appropriate for membership
- b Applications for admission shall be processed in accordance with the policies and procedures of this Corporation relating to the admission of new agencies. These policies and procedures shall provide for the Accreditation Committee to review the issues pertaining to accreditation and to make recommendations in that regard to the Executive Committee which will consider the other issues pertaining to admission as well as the recommendation of the Accreditation Committee. The Executive Committee shall in turn make its recommendation to the Board which will vote on said recommendation.

SECTION 7 2

For the purpose of sharing the joint funds to be raised by the United Way of Payne County, Inc , each Member Agency so sharing shall sign an agreement with the United Way incorporating the following

a To conduct no benefits, campaigns or solicitations for financial assistance for ordinary routine purposes, nor any similar campaign for special financial purposes within the geographic area of the United Way except with the written consent first obtained by the United Way of Payne County Board of Directors

- b After being given full consideration and hearing, to accept the apportionment of funds made to it by the Allocations Committee and approved by the United Way of Payne County Board of Directors
- c To maintain a reasonable management, with a qualified board of unpaid directors or administrative committee and a responsible county or local representative
- d To cooperate with other social agencies in preventing duplication of effort and in promoting effective service and efficiency and economy of administration
- e To undertake no new line of work or substantial expansion of service in community except with consent first obtained from the United Way of Payne County Board of Directors
- f To keep complete and regular books of account open to inspection by a representative of the United Way of Payne County
- g To file with the United Way of Payne County, at the end of each fiscal year and otherwise upon request, an accurate copy of a complete and satisfactory financial statement certified as to its correctness by the treasurer and president of the organization, and a financial statement showing assets and liabilities of the organization, to submit to the United Way other reasonable information concerning finances, programs, etc , and in such form as the United Way of Payne County Board of Directors or Allocations Committee or Accreditation Committee may require
- h To abide by the rules and regulations promulgated by the United Way of Payne County Board of Directors

SECTION 73

A Member Agency shall cease to be a Member Agency (1) by its written withdrawal as such sent to and approved by the Board or (2) by action taken by the Board upon the recommendation of the Admissions Committee made pursuant to the policies and procedures of this Corporation as to the revocation of membership

ARTICLE VIII Meetings

SECTION 8 1 Members There shall be an annual meeting of the Members in the month of January each year at such time and place as the Board of Directors shall determine, for the purpose of electing the Directors, receiving reports and transacting any business presented to it. When circumstances justify, a later date may be set by the Executive Committee provided that positive effort shall be made to avoid a date later than February 15. Additional meetings of Members may be held on call of the Board of Directors and must be called upon petition in writing of fifteen (15) or more Members.

SECTION 82

Board of Directors

- a The organizational meeting of the Board of Directors shall be held annually as soon as possible after the annual meeting of Members for the purpose of electing Officers, and transacting such other business as may come before it
- b Not less than nine meetings of the Board of Directors shall be held during the year. Other Board meetings shall be held as are desirable for the effective administration of this organization.
- c Special meetings of the Board of Directors may be called at any time by the President, and shall be called on the written request of three (3) Directors

SECTION 83

Committees

All committees shall meet upon the call of their chairperson

SECTION 84

Notice

- a Member meetings Notice of Member meetings shall be given by local newspaper publicity at least five (5) days before the meeting
- b Board of Directors meetings Notice of meetings of the Board of Directors shall be given by written or electronic notice (email or text message), sent to each Director at least three (3) days before the meeting
- c Committee meetings Notice of committee meetings may be given by any type of notice

ARTICLE IX Quorum

SECTION 9 1

Member Meetings A quorum for a regular or special meeting of Members shall consist of at least 22 voting Members

SECTION 9 2

Board of Directors A quorum for a regular or special meeting of the Board of Directors of this organization shall consist of one more than fifty (50%) of the total number of directors then serving on the Board of Directors

SECTION 93

Committees The members present at a committee meeting shall constitute a quorum

ARTICLE X Amendments

SECTION 10 1

These by-laws may be enlarged, amended or repealed in all or in part by a majority vote of the Board of Directors at any regular or special meeting of the Members provided

a That the proposed amendment shall have first been submitted to the Board of Directors for review at least five (5) days prior to the meeting at which the amendments are to be approved
