The Master Cares Ministry supports the people in and around the village of Rakai, Uganda in many ways including education, discipleship/spiritual development, micro-finance loans, job creation and sanitation and water wells.

The ministry has supported the Nambarizi School in Uganda, which by providing education to the children provides them a greater opportunity to grow and thrive as they reach adulthood. To do more in this area the Masters Foundation purchased a school in 2013 and made the Mater Cares Christian School ready for its February 2014 opening (it opened with over 80 students).

Our Director of Spiritual Development works with area Pastors and their churches to become more familiar with the word of God through one-to-one discipleship and by designing and facilitating small group Bible studies. The aim of the spiritual development ministry is to equip all believers with effective tools to spread the gospel of Christ and to improve the spiritual quality of life for the people in and around Rakai, Uganda.
