	Land Projects:
	MLR worked with numerous landowners in 2016 to permanently protect their private lands for continued agricultural production, open
	space, and natural habitat. Fourteen of these landowners donated or sold conservation easements to MLR that protected over
	32,259 acres, including additional acreage in the Greater Yellowstone and Northern Continental Divide ecosystems bordering
	Yellowstone and Glacier national parks. Nearly 43 miles of river/stream frontage on some of Montana's blue ribbon trout fisheries
	were protected in perpetuity. Over 85% of the easements completed in 2015 were adjacent to or within 5 miles of
	properties already protected by conservation easements. MLR is near that 1,000,000 acres of land protected with 990,323 acres
	of agricultural/recreational lands in Montana currently under easement. That acreage includes 162,023 acres of crop/hap/pasture
	lands; 828,023 acres of forest/range lands; 1,675 miles of river/stream frontage; 546,743 acres of prime elk habitat; and 10,070
	acres of wetlands.

	and every property on which MLR holds a conservation easement. This monitoring includes a visit to the subject property and
	discussions with the landowners and managers. The stewardship staff also works with existing easement holders to supply natural
	resource information and contacts for the landowner to improve their land holdings for conservation purposes Stewardship staff
	also works with legal counsel in regard to any potential issues that arise regarding interpretation or enforcement of conservation
	easements held by MLR. For a list of stewardship and monitoring related expenditures, please see Schedule O.

The Restatement of Deed of Conservation Easement and Grant Deed of Conservation Easement on Additional Lands protected an additional 531 acres that the landowner purchased since the original donation in 2013. These two new parcels border the existing easement property to the north and to the south and protect an additional 4.5 miles of river and stream frontage. The property in total can now transfer only in two parcels (one of which will be strictly for open space and agricultural purposes, there are no residential building rights on one of these two parcels).
- 5) Switchback Ranch This 16,728-acre ranch is located in the Stillwater River Valley near Red Lodge, Montana The original 15,763 acres was protected via a Restatement of Deeds of Conservation Easement and Grant Deed of Conservation Easement on Additional Lands recorded on December 24, 2014, as Document No. 360612 Easements, records of Stillwater County, Montana, and recorded on December 26, 2014, as Instrument File #360132, and rerecorded on December 30, 2014, as Instrument File #360146, records of Carbon County, Montana The landowner subsequently purchased 960 acres that was adjacent to the main ranch property The Grant Deed of Conservation Easement on Additional Lands and Ratification of Previous Restated Deed of Conservation Easement, recorded on December 27, 2016, as Instrument File #368607, records of Carbon County, Montana, and recorded on December 27, 2016, as Document #367457 Easements, records of Stillwater County, Montana The 2016 easement incorporated the newly purchased 960-acre parcel into the main ranch parcel of the original restated easement.
- 6) Gilleon Property -- This 1,995 acre property lies just northeast of the town of Cascade, Montana. The Restatement of Deeds of

  Conservation Easement and Grant Deed of Conservation Easement on Additional Lands consolidated four previously recorded Deeds of

  Conservation Easement that were granted on the property: 1) Deed of Conservation Easement recorded on December 17, 1996, as Reel

  288, Document 1335; 2) Deed of Conservation Easement recorded on December 21, 2001, as Document #R0019843; 3) Deed of
