Montana Conservation Voters Education Fund's primary exempt purpose is to provide research and public education to the members of conservation and environmental organizations in Montana, and other interested Montanans to protect Montana's clean air and water, wildlife, forests and open space. MCVEF seeks a more informed, educated and empowered conservation and environmental community in Montana, who takes part in this state's democratic process.

#### Form 990, Part III, Line 4a - Program Service Accomplishments

Conservation Policy Program: At the state level, MCVEF had a robust public policy and public education program related to public education and building support for policies to be pursued by the 2017 Montana State Legislature, including policy accountability and the 2015-2016 Legislative Interim.

Another state priority was to assess the impact of a proposal to transfer federal lands to the state. In addition, we worked with partners to develop a proactive state based public lands agenda. As in 2015, MCVEF provided policy analysis, distributed public information, coordinated media stories, prepared briefing materials and facilitated comments to the legislators, the Environmental Quality Council, and the Administration. MCVEF was responsible for generating more than a dozen letters to the editor and signed two op-ed's supporting a proactive public lands agenda.

A grant of \$25,000 was provided to Montana Conservation Voters for public policy services, including analysis of state legislative proposals; preparation and distribution of briefing papers; coordination of meetings with allied conservation and environmental groups; and coordination of more than 20 community meetings with

and Whitefish, MT).

At the federal level, MCVEF coordinated the Climate Action Coalition, working in partnership with the national League of Conservation Voters Education Fund and over a dozen conservation, public health and fish and wildlife groups. The key focus was to assess the revised EPA rule to reduce carbon emissions in the United States by 30% by 2030. Under the rule's revisions in 2016, Montana would have been required to reduce emissions by 47%. MCVEF worked to educate citizens, local and statewide decision makers on the impacts of climate change and the EPA rule on public health, fish and wildlife and a clean energy future, and to ensure the authority of the Environmental Protection Agency to protect public health under the Clean Air Act, including from the negative impact of carbon emissions. MCVEF leaders were part of letters to the editor and guest commentaries, and attended over a dozen meetings and events on the Clean Air Act, climate change and the Production Tax Credit. Additionally, MCVEF sponsored or

co-sponsored twenty one meetings and events throughout 2016 on clean energy and climate change, and reached out to legislative, statewide and local officials to engage them in this dialogue as well. During the final roll out of the Clean Power Plan rule through the summer of 2016, MCVEF assisted in coordinating comments and an assessment of the impact of the final plan on public health, fish and wildlife, water quality and jobs. We also coordinated coalition responses to the news in 2016 that the Plan would be put on hold by the federal courts, holding the Bullock Administration accountable to moving forward on clean energy and climate policy.

Community Organizing, Outreach and List Enhancement: Over the summer of 2016, MCVEF launched a door to door fundraising canvass. We knocked 9,317 doors, secured 2,411 petition signature of which 1,601 had good emails, and raised \$28,974 renewing 449 members and capturing 385 new members. This campaign was focused on transitioning from dirty coal and moving Montana toward a cleaner more renewable energy future based on rooftop solar, backyard wind and large scale wind farms. The campaign also consisted of regularly onboarding these newly acquired members with an email series that generated an additional 48 comments to Governor Bullock. worked with two other organizations on a grassroots campaign to oppose state and federal measures that would transfer federal lands to state control. The measures were defeated by the 2015 legislature but some legislators persisted in advocating the proposals ahead of the 2017 legislative session and at the federal level. MCVEF's campaign included:

visiting with 1,093 citizens at their doors, followed by calls to another 4,296 over the phone to discuss the proposals and identify their position. MCVEF followed this up with postcards mailed to ~ 5,000 citizens to submit a postcard addressed to Governor Steve Bullock to establish a pro-active state public lands program. Over 10% of those receiving the mailing responded. MCVEF also included a series of email communications, as well as targeted social media. This campaign is shaping up to be a key MCVEF program area, as an overwhelming majority of Montanans support protection and broad access to state and federal lands, and oppose transfer and privatization proposals:

MCVEF's 2016 List Project engaged 11 organizations, whose combined lists provided the environmental community almost 30,000 unique conservationists. We enhanced the data on all those conservationists member data with demographic and economic information.

Leadership and Staff Development: : Four MCVEF staff and two board members attended the national League of Conservation Voters/LCV Education Fund training meeting in Milwaukee, WI; two staff attended a fundraising training in Seattle, WA; two staff and a board member attended a public policy and advocacy training sessions in Washington, DC; two staff person attended a leadership training hosted by the Ballot Initiative Service Center; and one staff person took online training to learn how to effectively utilize MCVEF's new data base.

A new MCVEF Executive Director was recruited, screened, hired and orientation and training began in late 2015. Throughout 2016 the Executive Director participated in robust staff development and skills training opportunities, including two multi day boot camps for new executive directors from across the national LCV leagues.

The MCVEF Board of Directors and staff also continued a financial literacy program offered by the League of Conservation Voters, "Fun with Financials", which included a "Fiscal Fitness Test" and follow up leadership and staff development program.

strategy campaigns for various bills before the 2017 legislature affecting voter registration, vote by mail and polling place access. Groups support pursuing automatic and online voter registration, working with the Montana Secretary of State and Montana clerks and recorders (county election officials). MCVEF hosted a number of coalition partner meetings to develop joint strategy, assess policy tools, and identify allies. We also worked with policy experts to draft legislation ahead of the 2017 legislature.

MCVEF met with the Secretary of State and election officials in Yellowstone, Gallatin, Park, Lewis and Clark and Flathead counties to request clear and accessible information on web sites and through social media about how inactive voters could "re-activate" and vote in the 2016 general election. All county election officials made subsequent improvements on their web sites and some did publicity. This exclusion is a policy dilemma that MCVDEF has been addressing for several years, and which has come before the legislature. MCVEF also reached out via email and Facebook to the handful of its supporters who were on the inactive list and helped them update their voter registration.
