WE HAD VOLUNTEER TEACHERS COME AND TEACH ANYONE WHO WANTED TO COME AND TAKE CLASS. WE BEGAN TO BUILD OUR OUTREACH THROUGH THE USE OF FLYERS, FACEBOOK POSTS, AND WORD OF MOUTH. GOING TO NEARBY SCHOOLS, PARKS, AND CHURCHES TO SHARE WITH THE COMMUNITY ABOUT OUR NEW LOCATION. WE WERE ABLE TO START BRINGING IN FAMILIES TO PARTAKE IN THE DANCE CLASSES ALL FREE OF CHARGE.
