There were 843 competitors in 6,881 entries for these events. IGRA provided support for one rodeo school and four rough stock training academies. The IGRA University was held in Tucson, AZ in January offering, a range of classes for developing the leadership and skills required for organizing and managing rodeo events. The IGRA Convention took place in Austin, TX in November where rules and standards of competition were reviewed and updated. Four new members were inducted into the IGRA Rodeo Hall of Fame recognizing their lifetime achievements and contributions to gay rodeo. Work continued to build the archives of gay rodeo history, managing the current collection and searching for a permanent home where more of it can be made publicly accessible. The 21 independent member gay rodeo associations send representatives to the IGRA annual convention each November to vote in elections for the Executive Officers (President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer) of the Board. Other appointments (committee chairs, employees, consultants, etc.) are subject to review, approval and dismissal by the full Board of Directors.

The full IGRA convention body retains the authority to review, approve, suspend, or reverse decisions of the IGRA Board of Directors made between conventions.
