Providence is one of the larger health systems whose revenue is similar to that of Providence. Additionally, Providence's labor market continues to spread across health care and into general industry. Because of this, Providence also takes into consideration general industry for-profit market data, where applicable. Base salaries for Provi dence executives are generally targeted to the median level of the market, as identified by the independent consultant and reviewed with the Executive Compensation Committee.
