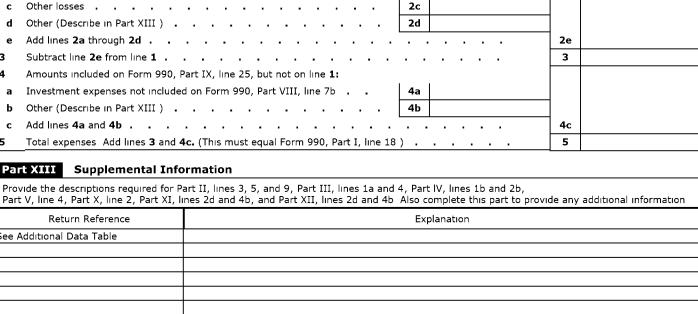



The fiduciary is also required to update his/her responses to the Conflict of Interest Questionnaire should any new information regarding an actual or potential conflict of interest for that fiduciary arise. In addition, should a subsequent conflict arise after the submission of the previously completed Conflict of Interest Questionnaire each fiduciary shall orally disclose, prior to the Boards or the relevant committees consideration of a proposed transaction or arrangement, the exist ence of any financial interest that he or she may have with respect to the transaction or arrangement. The board will then review the transaction or arrangement to determine if it is in SCHS's best interest, for its own benefit, and whether it is fair and reasonable. In conformity with the above determination, it shall make its decision as to whether to enter into the transaction or arrangement.
