

On 22nd March 2016 the first payment was advanced to Muryowa Cyrus mobility for the production of the 15 wheel chairs. Assessment was done and on 28th April the second payment to Mulyowa Cyrus for the production of 15 wheelchairs was effected.

On 27th July 2016, a third transfer was made to Mulyowa Cyrus Mobility for the production of more 15 wheelchairs and on 17th August 2016 the final payment was made.

All Funds have been utilized and 30 wheelchairs were produced and distributed to the 30 beneficiaries.

A total of \$ 4999.8 was given to the orthopedic factory and this included assessment of 30 children with disabilities each costing \$15.1 and production 30 wheelchair each costing 151.5 for the selected children with disabilities.

#### INTRODUCTION

This report presents the final progress towards achievement of the set objectives, planned activities and delivery of outputs of the one-year project on Provision of appropriate wheel chairs to children with physical disabilities in Uganda. The project was undertaken by YPDDF with financial support from Arthur B. Schultz Foundation.

#### **BACKGROUND**

The estimated 13% of children with disability prevalence live out to only 9% children with disabilities of school going age maneuvering in all circumstances to access education, either carried by their parents/guardians at the back and taken to classrooms or crawl down to reach schools. The challenges out of this situation leads to a high school drop out among children with disabilities in Uganda Education system. Note only children with disabilities are affected in the school education system but are also limited in participating in other community activities like their counterparts.

#### PROJECT OVERVIEW

The project was intended to address the challenge of limited access to wheel chair for children with physical disabilities in Uganda piloting in Wakiso and Mukono districts.

Goal: The overall goal of the project was to enhance the quality of life of children with disabilities and their families. This was done through providing them with appropriate wheel chairs to improve on the mobility challenges so that they are able to participate in all community activities

The project focused on two primary objectives:

Objective 1: To improve on the mobility of 30 children with disabilities in Mukono and Wakiso districts and increase on the enrollment and retention in community schools by 2016.

Objective 2: To increase capacity of users and 30 caregivers on proper use and maintenance of wheel chair by 2016.

In the last 12 months, a number of activities were implemented contributing to the realization of the project objectives. YPDDF's intervention is presented in this 12 month final report as shown below.


In the bid to address the above challenges YPDDF between the month of Marc 1 and July 2016 the project commenced with Assessment of 30 identified and selected children from the community that we serve most especially school going children with disabilities who lacked wheel chairs. This assessment involved visiting homes of the identified families of children with disabilities by YPDDF officers and the orthopedic doctor whose role was to assess the identified children to get the right measurements and to procure appropriate wheel chairs to all the assessed children with mobility problems.


Additionally the assessment also involved knowing the actual disability of the child, age, what caused the disability, weight of the child, who are the parent/guardians, the child movements and the social life of the child, attitude from other members at home, in school and at the entire community

Between the month of April , August, September 2016 after assessment of the 30 children, the orthopedic local factory started the procurement process of well fitted wheel chairs for the right disabilities of all the assessed children with disabilities and 30 appropriate wheel chairs have been produced and given out by YPDDF to the respective beneficiaries

Youth with Physical Disability Development Forum is thrived that a portion of 30 children with disabilities in the community that we serve have now access to well fitted and appropriate wheel chairs to their specific disabilities and this has improved on their. Mobility improvement among children with disabilities enables them to participate in any community activity as a child. Some of the children that have received wheelchair, have accessed schools, children's party and any other. This has made them more visible in the communities changing the community mindset on how they look and perceive children with disabilities. This has resulted into an appreciation that despite their disabilities, they are part and parcel of the community.

As if not enough, there has been dramatic change in the lives of these children with disabilities after acquiring appropriate wheel chair, they are now able to access some school facilities like toilets and classrooms without crawling down and engage in co-curricular school activities like their counterparts creating a good attitude among children with and without disabilities.


YPDDF is overwhelmed by the number of young stars who are still in need life-changing mobility appliances, rehabilitation services and access to quality education to transform a child's life.

2016 they produced a flyer that talked about challenges in life — young person and older person. Annual Mtg in Sept — during National Suicide Prevention Day. Many youth present — music and comedians. 4 recognized professionals to tell 3 most important things to prevent suicide: 1) Establish a mandatory mental health course in school. Lars mellon — had a daughter in Olaf's class and said this was the #1 most important. Been on National TV to discuss.
