### Postmarked By – January 9, 2017

The NRWA National Board of Directors has established the Joe & Jean Palmer Endowment Fund to honor the memory of a rural water leader and true friend. This scholarship will benefit the children of the rural water family attending institutions of higher learning.

A retired civil engineer and avid environmentalist, Palmer was a prominent figure in the local, state and national water industry. Although he was retired, he was a partner in Stevenson and Palmer Engineering and had held the post of president and CEO. He was co-founder of the Georgia Rural Water Association, serving as president of the organization for four years. He was president of National Rural Water Association from 1994 to 1996 and was named the 1991 NRWA Man of the Year. In recognition of his lobbying efforts as a member of the Water Industry Coordinating Committee, he was invited to the White House to witness the signing of the 1996 Safe Drinking Water Act.

From 1942 to 1969, he was in the U.S. Army, serving in World War II, Korea, and Vietnam. He was chosen as one of the military escorts for President John F. Kennedy's funeral cortege and was a member of President Lyndon B. Johnson's inaugural committee. Before he retired as a colonel, his last assignment was to the office of Joint Chiefs of Staff in the Pentagon. He received the Silver Star, two Legion of Merit awards, The Bronze Star, the Air Medal, the Joint Staff Commendation Medal and 12 other service medals.

A former science and chemistry teacher, Mrs. Palmer later owned and operated a gift shop and established an insurance agency, winning a number of awards from the insurance industry. Most recently, she had embarked on a successful career in real estate and investment counseling. The Palmers were killed in a traffic accident on May 8, 2000, in their hometown of Camilla, Georgia.

By resolution, the NRWA Rally 2000 in Washington D.C. was dedicated to the Palmers: "They were the epitome of Rural America ... Their character, ethics, and morals contributed to the success of their personal businesses as well as the success of rural water nationwide ... Rural Water has lost a catalyst, a champion, a leader, and a friend. Their importance and contributions to the rural water family will be felt for generations to come."
