CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION OF HRBT FOUNDATION

1. The name of the Corporation (hereinafter sometimes referred to as the "Corporation") is:

HRBT Foundation

- 2. The address of the Corporation's registered office in the State of Delaware is 1209 Orange Street, Wilmington, New Castle County, Delaware, 19801. The registered agent is The Corporation Trust Company.
- 3. The purpose of the Corporation is to promote charitable and educational activities within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"), including, but not limited to, the following:
- (a) making awards, grants or other distributions designed to promote the health, well-being and economic self-sufficiency of communities located in Columbia County and surrounding areas in the State of New York;
- (b) supporting activities that advance education, arts and culture in communities located in Columbia County and surrounding areas in the State of New York;
- (c) contributing to neighborhood renewal and revitalization including programs dedicated to expanding home ownership and affordable rental housing opportunities, historic preservation and environmental protection in Columbia County and surrounding areas in the State of New York;
- (d) supporting youth development programs to improve life options through education and work skills in Columbia County and surrounding areas in the State of New York;
- (e) supporting community organizations that contribute to the quality of life in Columbia County and surrounding areas in the State of New York; and
- (f) receiving by gift and otherwise acquiring and holding all property, real or personal.

In furtherance of these purposes, the Board of Directors shall have the power to make grants to any organization organized and operated exclusively for charitable, scientific or educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Code. The Board of Directors shall review all requests for funds from other organizations, shall require that such requests specify the use to which the funds will be put, and if the Board of Directors approves the request, shall authorize payment of such funds to the approved grantee. The Board of Directors may require that grantees furnish a periodic accounting to show that the funds were expended for the purposes approved by the Board of Directors. The Board of Directors may, in its absolute discretion, refuse to make any grants or contributions or otherwise render financial assistance to any organization.

4. As a means of accomplishing the foregoing purposes, the Corporation shall have the power to do any and all acts as are necessary or conducive to the attainment of any of the objects and purposes hereinbefore set forth, to the same extent and as fully as any natural person might or could do; provided, however, that no substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

In addition, notwithstanding any provision of this Certificate of Incorporation or any provisions of applicable State law to the contrary, the Corporation shall not have the power:

- (a) to exercise any authority or power either expressly, by interpretation, or by operation of law that will prevent it at any time from qualifying and continuing to qualify as an organization described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Code;
- (b) to be operated for the primary purpose of carrying on a trade or business for profit;
- (c) to use any part of its income to reduce a debt on property which will revert ultimately to private individuals; or
- (d) to engage in any activities which are unlawful under the laws of the United States, the State of Delaware, or any other jurisdiction where its activities are conducted.
- 5. No loan shall be paid to any officer, director, member, creator, or organizer of the Corporation, or substantial contributor to it, except as reasonable compensation for services rendered and/or as a reasonable allowance for authorized expenditures incurred on behalf of the Corporation; and no part of the assets or net earnings, current or accumulated, of the Corporation shall ever be distributed to or divided among such persons or inure, be used for, or accrue to any such person or other private individual.

- 6. The Corporation shall be a membership corporation and shall have no authority to issue capital stock. The members of the Corporation shall be the directors thereof, who shall be nominated and elected by the incorporator immediately upon the organization of the Corporation and who shall act as the members and directors of the Corporation until the election of their successors as provided in the By-laws of the Corporation.
- 7. The affairs and business of the Corporation shall be managed and conducted by the Board of Directors. The qualifications, number, tenure, powers, and duties of the members of the Board of Directors shall be as provided in the By-laws of the Corporation.
- 8. No director of the Corporation shall be personally liable to the Corporation for monetary damages for breach of fiduciary duty as a director, except for liability (i) for any breach of the director's duty of loyalty to the Corporation, (ii) for acts or omissions not in good faith which involve intentional misconduct or a knowing violation of law, (iii) under Section 174 of the Delaware General Corporation Law, or (iv) for any transaction from which the director derived an improper personal benefit.
- 9. In furtherance and not in limitation of the powers conferred upon the Board of Directors by law, the Board of Directors shall have the power to (i) make, adopt, alter, or repeal, from time to time, the By-laws of the Corporation;
- 10. In the event of the liquidation, dissolution, or winding up of the affairs of the Corporation, whether voluntary, involuntary, or by operation of law, the Board of Directors of the Corporation shall, except as may be otherwise provided by law, transfer all of the assets of the Corporation in such manner as the directors, in the exercise of their discretion, may by a unanimous vote; provided, however, that upon said liquidation, dissolution, or winding up of the affairs of the Corporation, its assets shall be distributed (i) to one or more organizations or entities described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Code; (ii) to the Federal Government, or a State or local government for a public purpose; or (iii) if pursuant to a decree of a court with jurisdiction, to another organization to be used in such manner as in the judgement of such court will best accomplish the general purposes for which the Corporation is herein organized.
- 11. The Corporation reserves the right to amend, alter, or repeal any provisions contained in this Certificate of Incorporation in a manner now or hereafter prescribed by applicable statutes, and all rights conferred herein are granted subject to this reservation; provided, however, that no amendment shall authorize the Board of Directors to conduct the affairs of the Corporation in any manner or for any purpose contrary to the provisions of Section 501(c)(3) of the Code.
 - 12. The Corporation shall have perpetual existence.

- 13. The Corporation shall indemnify its officers and directors to the full extent permitted by Section 145 of the Delaware General Corporation Law, as amended from time to time.
