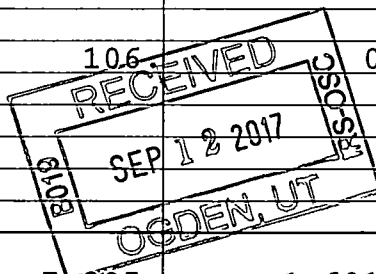



Evaluation Guidelines

1. Whether or not the program services a “charitable purpose”
2. Whether or not the requesting agency operates independently or as a chapter of a national organization, except those which are specifically mentioned in the trust agreement or which have previously been supported

4. Possible duplication of government or private sector efforts
5. Whether or not the success or failure of the program can be measured
6. Evidence of broad community support

Limitations

1. Programs or organizations designed to influence legislation or elect candidates to public office
2. Agencies which are operating as chapters of a state or national organization, unless specifically mentioned in the trust agreement
3. Individuals
4. Tickets or tables for benefit purposes
5. Advertising for benefit purposes
6. Loans or investments

The rejection of a proposal should not be construed as a negative reaction to a particular organization or project, but rather as a selective choice on the part of the Lewis Family Foundation Trustees to use limited resources in an alternative fashion.

All proposals or requests for grants from not-for-profit, tax exempt organizations should be submitted on the organizations stationery and must include the following information:

A. Description of the project, which should include:

1. Verification of community need
2. Challenge to be addressed
3. Target group for project
4. Project goals and method for achieving the goals
5. Itemized budget for the project
6. Specific amount requested

B. The ruling of the Internal Revenue Service as to the tax-exempt status – 501(C)3

C. Agreement to report to the First Option Bank Trust Department results of the programs which were supported.

D. All proposals should be direct, concise and simply phrased. Multiple proposals in a single calendar year from one organization are discouraged.

Recipient Accountability

It is the responsibility of the grant recipient to ensure that it is used for the purpose indicated in the request. In certain cases, the recipient may be asked to sign a statement to this effect. If for any reason the grant is used for other than the stated purpose, the Foundation reserves the right to withdraw funding.
