

The new bylaws add clarification about the charter and composition of the standing committees. 7. To allow for action via remote communication, the bylaws were updated to acknowledge the presence of and the validity of votes by trustees even if they participate via remote communication. 8. The Secret ary of the board is now an employee of MCAD. Previously, they were a member of the board who could supervise the Executive Assistant to the President with the associated duties. 9. The indemnification article was expanded and now covers heirs, executors, and administrat ors of trustees. 10. The conflict of interest article has addit
