Required attachments to the application include: (1) a copy of most recent 501(c)(3) certification from the IRS, (2) a signed statement that the 501(c)(3) certification from the IRS for your organization has not been revoked, (3) a signed statement that you are aware that any grant dollars received from this foundation cannot be used to lobby government officials or attempt to influence legislation or public policy, (4) a signed statement that your organization is not currently involved in any lawsuit either filed against it or filed on it's behalf, (5) an independent audit for the most recently completed fiscal year, (6) a management letter from your auditor.
