

The Executive Board serves as APHA's Governing Body. The Executive Board is 24-member body and composed of 17 elected members, out of which 5 are officers and 7 are ex-officio-3 voting and 4 non-voting. The Executive Board members are elected among individual members of the Association for terms of four years each by the Governing Council.
