United Way of Northern New Jersey has an annual endowment spending policy that is specifically designed to assist in funding annual programming objectives and to preserve the value of the investment portfolio over time. The spending policy is between 5% and 6% of the fund value averaged over the preceding five year period as of June 30th of each period. In establishing this policy, United Way of Northern New Jersey considered the long term expected return on its endowment. Accordingly, over the long term, United Way of Northern New Jersey expects the current spending policy to allow its endowment to grow and maintain its value to support operations in the future. To meet these objectives, United Way of Northern New Jersey utilizes a total return investment approach which emphasizes total investment return, consisting of investment income and realized and unrealized gains or losses and, accordingly, invests in equities, fixed income, and money market accounts. In addition to the general endowment funds, there are funds functioning as endowments which have donor im posed restrictions as to time and purpose, along with varying valuation dates and formulas for the calculation and release of same.
