It then became an independent organization when the hospital merged with UPMC in October 2001. Through the Foundation, generous donations large and small from individuals, corporations, foundations, and community partners have a direct and immediate impact on Children's Hospital's ability to transform young lives through unparalleled care and deep compassion. Rooted in philanthropy, Children's is sustained by generous community support, setting the standards of excellence in pediatric care. In FY 2017, the Foundation sent more than \$20 million in contributions to the Hospital in support of research, clinical programs, medical education and funds for free care For more than 125 years, Children's has been a fixture in Pittsburgh and the surrounding tri-state region. What began in 1890 as a single cot endowed by the entrepreneurial son of a local pediatrician, has grown into a world-renowned children's hospital dedicated to improving the health and well-being of all children Today. 


