

For FY17, we reported community benefit and served und er the state Medicaid programs in all 6 locations. The majority of remaining community ben efit offered from all locations was for bereavement and grief support groups for Hospice, as well as offerings of community education, in-kind donations. We also provided education to nursing students, as well as participated in various other health fair events. Our pri mary business offerings are home health. Anospice and given the rural nature of much of ND and MN, we often are the only option for patients living in smaller communities that may not readily have access to other healthcare facilities.
