The Christ hospital ("TCH") is an Ohio nonprofit corporation formed in June of 1891 TCH is tax-exempt under section 501(c)(3) of the internal revenue code ("the code") and functions as a hospital organization as described in section 509(a)(1) and 170(b)(1)(a)(iii) of the code TCH's mission for the 125 years of its operations has been to improve the health of our community and to be a regional exemplar in creating patient value through exceptional outcomes and patient experience provided at an affordable and responsible cost that ensures access to all members of our community without regard to financial status or other factors such as race, ethnicity, beliefs or gender Through its main hospital campus in Mt.
